

Holidaying with your dog * at Coastal Retreats

Guests bringing pets are asked to adhere to our booking conditions relating to the acceptance of pets to our properties. Dogs must be declared and paid for BEFORE your holiday. Thank You.

Please note:

Both the property and the gardens should be kept and left clean and undamaged

It is also **IMPORTANT** that you ensure that your pet is:

- Not allowed on any furniture
- Never allowed in any bedrooms
- Never left in the property on its own
- Not allowed to create any kind of nuisance to your neighbours and please be aware of grazing livestock around the area.
- Dogs must be kept on their leads at all times and any poop scooped!

If you are not confident in your pet's behaviour, or are visiting somewhere where dogs aren't allowed, there are local kennels and day care as follows:

Out and about in Northumberland

All of Northumberland's beaches are dog friendly, except on Ross Back Sands during the seabird breeding season from May to July. Dogs are also welcome onto land at one of the Farne Islands, Longstone, although they are not allowed in the lighthouse. At Bamburgh Castle, they are permitted in the grounds.

Dogs on leads are allowed into the grounds at most English Heritage and National Trust properties. The walk from Craster to Dunstanburgh Castle is also a lead only area due to grazing livestock.

Dogs are not permitted in The Alnwick Garden, Alnwick Castle or at Howick Hall Gardens.
